Re: 2016 Primary Election / 17 Year Olds Eligible to Vote

Dear Voter:

Our system indicates you will be 18 years of age before the 2016 General Election; you have submitted a valid Voter Registration form prior to books closing on May 10, 2016; and your registration indicates you have selected one of the major parties (Democratic or Republican) participating in the Primary Election. **Therefore pursuant to House Bill 138 you are eligible to vote in the 2016 Primary Election on or after May 18, 2016.**

Enclosed is a bookmark with the voting locations and important election dates for the 2016 Primary. After May 18th you may vote either by Absentee Ballot, at an Early Vote location, or on Election Day which is June 7, 2016.

This letter will serve as notice of registration until you receive an official voter registration card in the mail when you turn 18 years of age. When you present yourself to vote for the 2016 Primary you must provide your name, year of birth and address as registered to receive your ballot. After you are 18 you will be eligible to participate in all future elections including special elections, school elections, municipal elections and all future Primary and General elections.
