

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Asbestos Abatement in Commissioners Chamber

On November 21, 2013, the carpet layer from Barnett Carpets had begun to pull up the carpet in the Lincoln County Commission Chamber when he noticed tile and mastic under the carpet. He suspected that the tile and mastic had asbestos present and halted his work and informed me about the situation. At this time, I called the Environmental Department to report that we suspected asbestos present. I spoke with Margaret Doyle from the Ruidoso office and she advised me that Lincoln County would have to get the suspected floor tiles tested and if positive, appropriately abate prior to installing the carpet. I proceeded to contact Southwest Hazard Control out of Las Cruces, New Mexico. Michael Armendariz traveled to Carrizozo and is taking samples of the tile to El Paso to have it tested. Southwest gave me a quote for the abatement of the Chamber. The quote consists of abatement, samples, clearance, disposal and mobilization for a total of \$9,566.49 including tax.

I am aware that other Hazard Companies are capable of doing this kind of assessment and abatement, however Lincoln County is in the process of expanding the Courthouse and Sheriff's office at this time and the Court has been using the Commission Chamber for court hearings because of the noise levels created by the construction on the North side of the building.

This situation creates a threat to conduct county and court business. An immediate need for this work that cannot be met through normal procurement methods and the lack of which will seriously threaten the functioning of government.

Purchase order # 897447 is hereby authorized to remedy this situation.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

The CONTRACT, ATTACHMENTS, and TERMS AND CONDITIONS constitute the entire agreement between SHC and the CLIENT. No other conditions, warranties, guarantees, scopes of work, payment terms or arrangements apply. SHC shall not be responsible for delays resulting from change orders, labor disputes, fire, delivery, adverse weather conditions, acts of the government, or acts of God beyond the direct control of SHC. Delays or losses affecting SHC, which are in whole or in part the result of actions taken by the CLIENT, its subcontractors or representatives, shall be the sole responsibility of the CLIENT. SHC, at its discretion, may seek relief and/or restitution from the CLIENT.

REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

SHC shall comply with all applicable federal, state, regional, county and local statutes, rules, and regulations relating to worker health and safety and environmental protection, in effect at the time of bid. Specifically, SHC shall comply with all applicable sections of 40CFR, 29CFR and 49CFR or state, regional, county or local regulations, whichever is most stringent. Changes in statutes, rules and regulation which take effect following the PROPOSAL date and prior to SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION shall be considered a CHANGE ORDER which may affect the QUOTATION PRICE and/or the SCHEDULE. Application for site specific permits shall be the responsibility of the CLIENT unless otherwise defined in this PROPOSAL AND STANDARD CONTRACT.

PERFORMANCE OF WORK

SHC shall supervise and perform the work in a craftsman like manner. SHC shall be solely responsible for and have control over construction means, methods, techniques, sequences and procedures and for coordinating all portions of the work defined by the SCOPE OF WORK. SHC shall provide all services, labor, materials, equipment and facilities defined as SHC's responsibility in the SCOPE OF WORK.

CHANGE ORDERS

The CLIENT, without invalidating the STANDARD CONTRACT, may request, in writing, additions or modifications to the SCOPE OF WORK authorized by written Change Order signed by the Client and SHC. The cost to the CLIENT from a change in the Scope of Work shall be determined by SHC and authorized through mutual agreement and by change order. The Contract Sum and Contract period shall be changed only by Change Order.

TAXES AND INSURANCE

SHC shall pay FICA, FUTA and SUTA taxes as well as WORKMANS COMPENSATION INSURANCE for its employees. SHC also provides VEHICLE INSURANCE in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 for its company vehicles and General Liability Insurance of \$1,000,000.00. No other taxes or insurance are included in the PROPOSAL AND STANDARD CONTRACT unless specified under the SCOPE OF WORK.

SUBCONTRACTS

Contracts between SHC and Subcontractor(s) shall (1) require Subcontractor(s) to be bound to SHC by the terms of the Contract, and to assume toward SHC all the obligations and responsibilities which SHC, by the Contract, assumes toward the Client, and (2) allow the Subcontractor(s) the benefit of all rights, remedies and redress afforded to SHC by this Contract.

PAYMENT

For projects requiring up through thirty (30) days for completion the CLIENT shall pay SHC fifty percent (50%) of the QUOTATION PRICE at the time of order and the balance upon receipt of the final invoice. For projects requiring over thirty (30) days for completion, the CLIENT shall pay SHC twenty-five percent (25%) of the QUOTATION PRICE at the time of order. Progress payments shall be invoiced monthly. All invoices shall be payable not later than fifteen (15) days following receipt of invoice by the CLIENT. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

SHC shall be responsible to the CLIENT for the acts and omissions of SHC's employees, Subcontractors and their agents and employees, and other persons performing portions of the Work under a contract with SHC. As between the Client and SHC, any applicable statute of limitations shall commence to run and any alleged cause of action shall be deemed to have accrued (1) not later than the date of Substantial Completion for acts or failures to act occurring prior to the relevant date of Substantial Completion; (2) not later than the date of issuance of the final Certificate for Payment for acts or failures to act occurring subsequent to the relevant date of Substantial Completion and prior to issuance of the final Certificate for Payment; and (3) not later than the date of the relevant act or failure to act by SHC for acts or failures to act occurring after the date of the final Certificate for Payment. It shall be the obligation of the CLIENT to exercise due diligence to discover and to bring to the attention of SHC at the earliest possible time, any ambiguities, discrepancies, inconsistencies, or conflicts in or between any documents attached hereto or incorporated by reference herein. 



IV. WORK PLAN (§ 61.145(b)(4)(x - xi))
Description of planned work and methods to be used and description of affected facility components (i.e. acoustical ceiling scrape, whole pipe removal, TSI removal, roofing removal, etc.) Manual method will be used for removal of carpet, 12x12 floor tile & mastic (~1,500 sf) in the courthouse. Workers will spray amended water during the abatement.

Filtration pump will be used to filter the water. Workers will use Half-face respirators during the abatement process. ACM will be placed within double 6 mil asbestos-bags. Bags will be transported to the asbestos waste land fill.
