

RESOLUTION 2020- 41
ADJUSTING PRECINCT BOUNDARIES AND
CREATING NEW PRECINCTS IN LINCOLN COUNTY

Whereas, Section 1-3-12C NMSA 1978 requires the Board of County Commissioners and the County Clerks to adjust all precinct boundaries prior to each federal decennial census pursuant to the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act, and

Whereas, Section 1-3-12D NMSA 1978 states adjustments to the standard base maps submitted and as revised and approved by the secretary of state pursuant to the provisions of the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act shall become the official precincts of each county for the 2021 redistricting, and

Whereas, Section 1-3-1B NMSA 1978 requires a precinct be divided or its boundaries adjusted if the precinct has had more than 750 votes cast based on the two most recent general elections, and


Whereas, Lincoln County, in conjunction with the State of New Mexico approved vendor for technical support, identified multiple minor precinct boundary adjustments in accordance with the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act, and


Whereas, Lincoln County also identified one precinct for split creating an additional precinct as defined to comply with Section 1-3-1B NMSA 1978; to facilitate the redistricting of County Commission Districts.





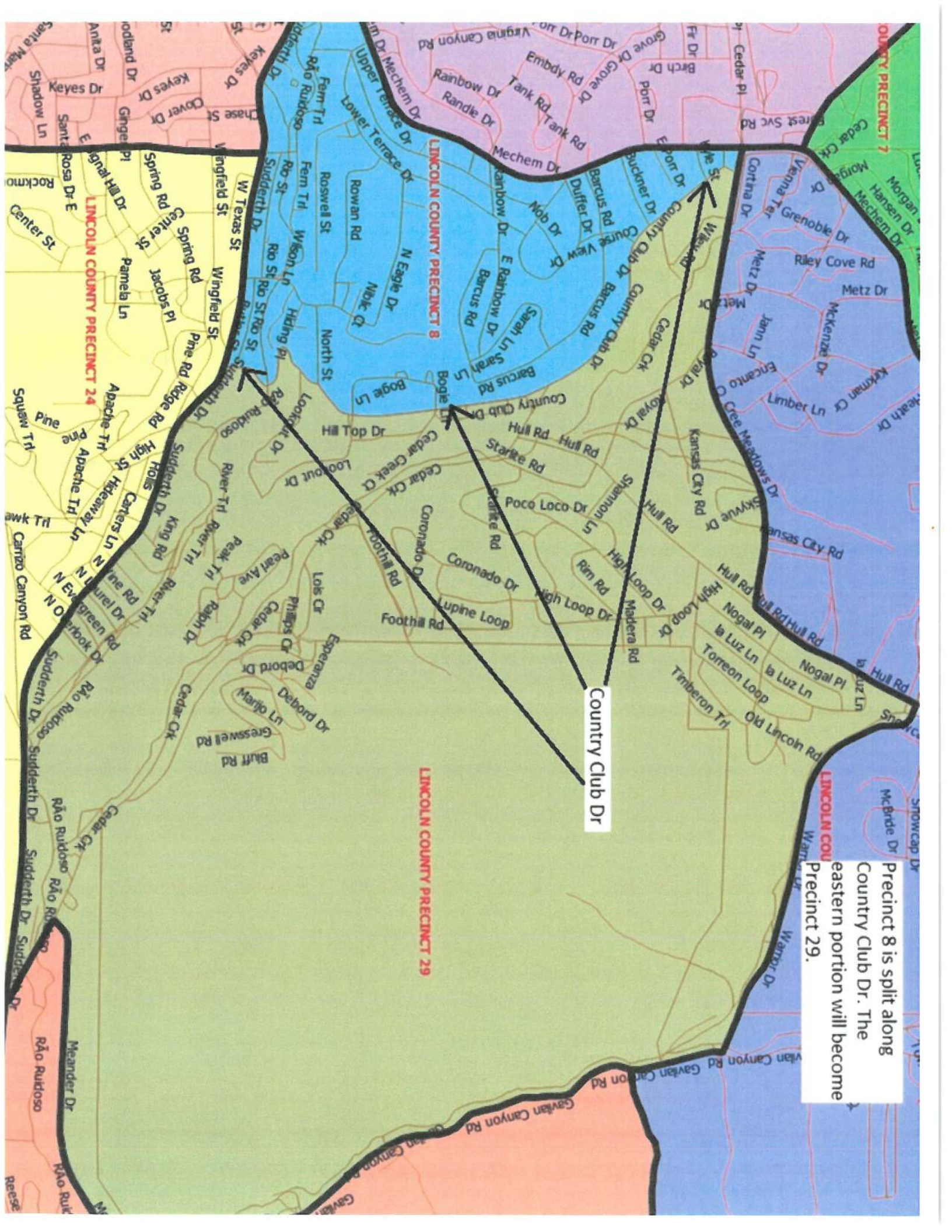
